Dementia is an acquired clinical syndrome characterised by the loss of cognitive and intellectual functions, without impairment of perception or consciousness. It has many causes and is usually progressive. This multidisciplinary one-day course for health professionals aims to give participants a greater awareness and broader understanding of the complexities of this very variable neurodegenerative disorder, together with an update of current management strategies.
